

Recovery Coach

Summary:

A Recovery Coach is a member of the interdisciplinary team and assists counselors with providing supportive services, recovery engagement, and healthy connections amongst the clients. The Coach provides the hope and support necessary to assist clients to make lifestyle changes that support their recovery outcomes. The Coach will share his/her experiences of health, hope and determination, and the impact of recovery challenges on their success.

Duties:

- Assists with bridging the gap between clients and staff and aid clients seeking assistance when appropriate
- Provides a model for both clients by demonstrating healthy recovery skills
- Motivates clients' successful completion of program assignments and responsibilities
- Delivers peer-led services that assist clients to set and achieve goals, increase healthy lifestyle habits, maximize and prioritize time in class and counseling
- Co-facilitate program classes and process groups
- Assists with case management related to client identification, medical, and legal issues
- Delivers clients to doctor appointments, interviews, and classes when needed
- Ensures clients adhere to rules and follow appropriate guidelines
- Operates mission vehicles following Jimmie Hale Mission policies
- Assists with security in monitoring the building's and client's activities
- Assists with drug testing when needed
- Any other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Complete Peer Support Specialist Training and acquire certification within the first year from a recognized organization, agency, or board evidencing expertise (NAADAC) in areas appropriate to a substance use disorder.
- High school diploma or GED required to be obtained within first year.
- Must reach a minimum of two years of personal recovery experience in maintaining healthy abstinence from substance use within first year.

- Ability to communicate professionally and clearly
- Ability to get along well with others
