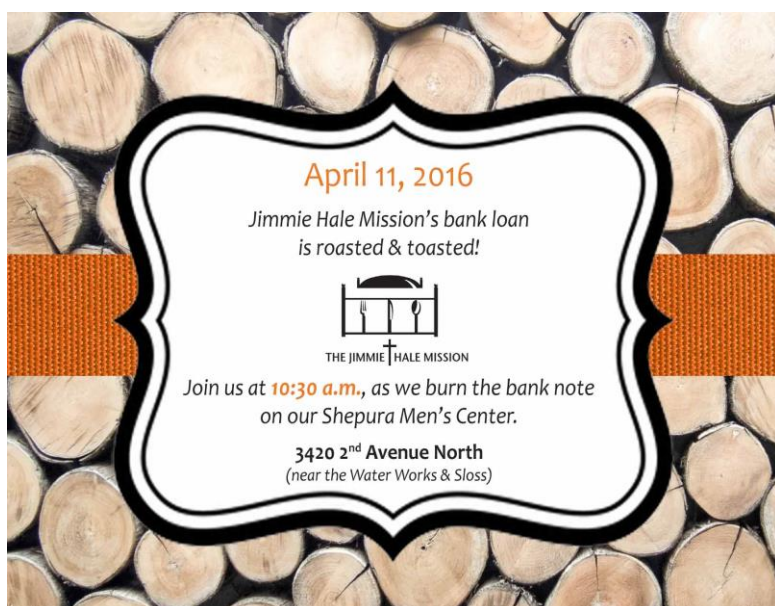
The Jimmie Hale Mission torches bank note on Men's Center
